Ortho Tips


If your bracket or band is still attached to the wire, you should leave it in place and put wax on it. If the band or brace comes out entirely, wrap the bracket with a tissue and bring it with you to your appointment.

Flu?

Due to the recent reports regarding the fast growing flu, we are encouraging patients to reschedule their appointments if they have flu-like symptoms, especially a fever. For your safety, we will also stay home is we are exhibiting flu-like symptoms.

Does Your Child or Teen Snore?

Does you child or teenager snore on a regular basis? This means three or more times per week.

Last summer, the American Academy of Pediatrics published guidelines that recommended that children with a history of regular snoring be evaluated by their family doctors or pediatricians for obstructive sleep apnea syndrome. Snoring is frequently associated with sleep apnea in both children and adults. Obstructive sleep apnea can contribute to cardiovascular problems, diabetes, and other systemic problems.

Snoring is relatively common but obstructive sleep apnea is much less common. The number of children who have obstructive sleep apnea will be far fewer than the number who snore but snoring is a very good screening test to trigger a more detailed evaluation that might demonstrate obstructive sleep apnea.

The Academy goes on to say that if regular snoring is associated with labored breathing during sleep, bedwetting, morning headaches, daytime sleepiness, problems in school or ADHD, other learning problems, underweight or overweight, large tonsils and adenoids, a small or recessive lower jaw (among others), failure to thrive, or high blood pressure, a more in depth evaluation is <u>definitely</u> indicated.

The treatment for snoring in a child or teen is either removal of the tonsils and adenoids or palatal expansion (orthodontic expander) or a combination of both. Palatal expansion is a routine procedure in an orthodontic office and easily done from age 4 and up. If your child snores or has had a diagnosis of sleep apnea but has not yet seen an orthodontist, we would be happy to evaluate him or her for palatal expansion. You can just call and make an appointment without a referral from your dentist or physician.

Interestingly, as I was writing this article, a mother of a current patient asked me about her son and his snoring. He has always snored every night and his teachers have complained about him falling asleep in class. That is just the kind of scenario that I am talking about: snoring plus one other factor which in this case was daytime sleepiness.
